### **SWEDEN ELECTION 2006**

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 The Swedish data set for CSES module 3  
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The election TO THE Swedish *Riksdag* was held on September 17, 2006. Local and regional elections were held at the same time.

The Swedish election study is separated into two samples, one pre election sample and one post election sample. The CSES module 3 is included in the post election part of the study, both in a full scale interview and in a shortened version of the questionnaire. The shortened version was offered to respondent's who refused a full scale interview. Those of the respondent's which refused the shortened interview were offered an extremely shortened version of the questionnaire in which only one of the CSES questions where asked (Q22). Due to this there are a lot of missing cases for the other CSES question in the data set (408 missing cases).

Due to Swedish data laws the respondents in the Swedish election study 2006 were asked if they agreed to that their answers would be part of international data set accessible on the Internet. Among the respondents there were 2 percent (30 respondents) which disagreed to this.

The table below show the proportion of respondents that agreed or did not agree to be present on the Internet in different social and political groups. The result shows only minor differences. But low educated people and people not at all interested in politic were somewhat more negative to that their answers would be accessible on the Internet.
