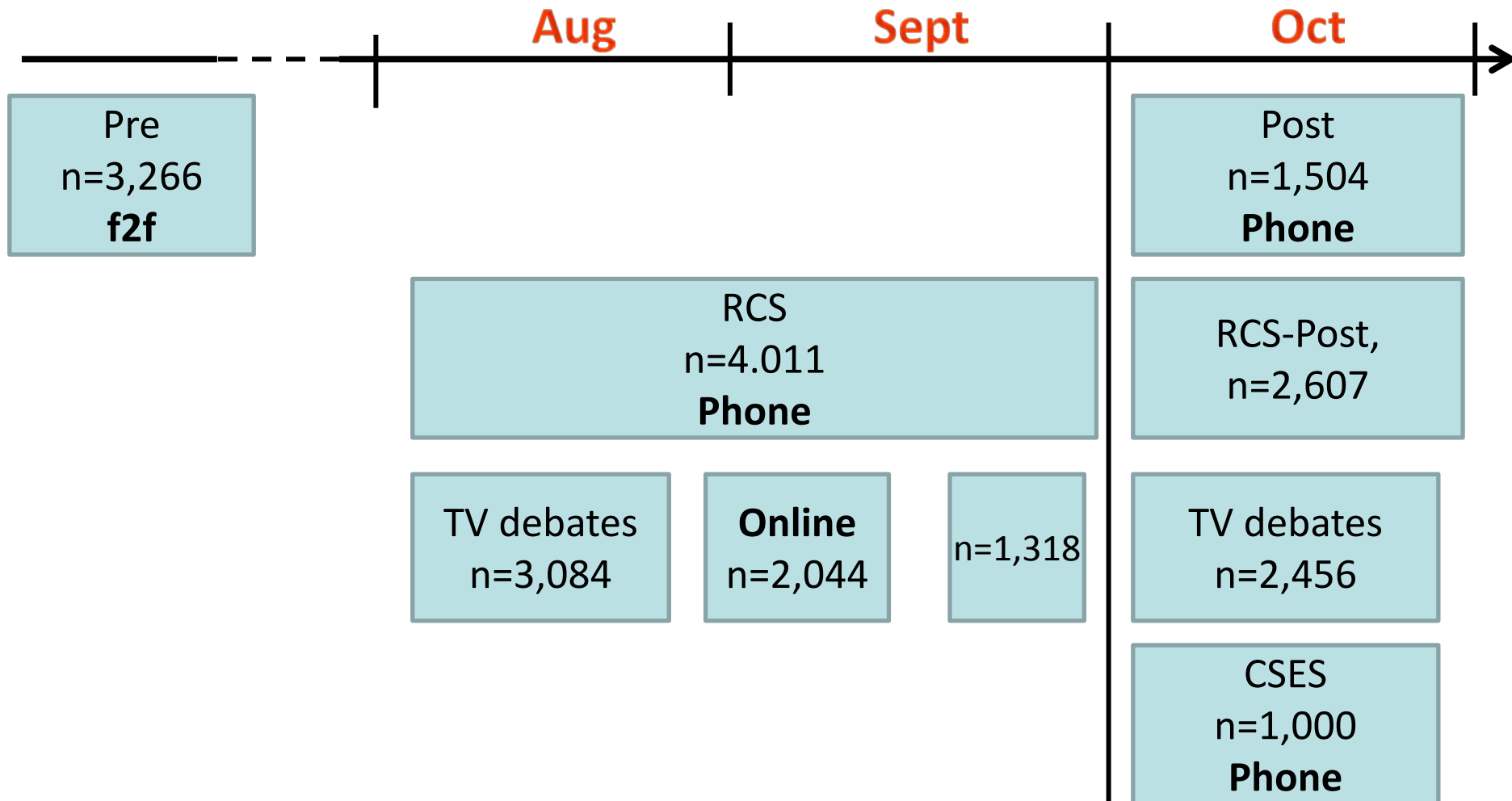

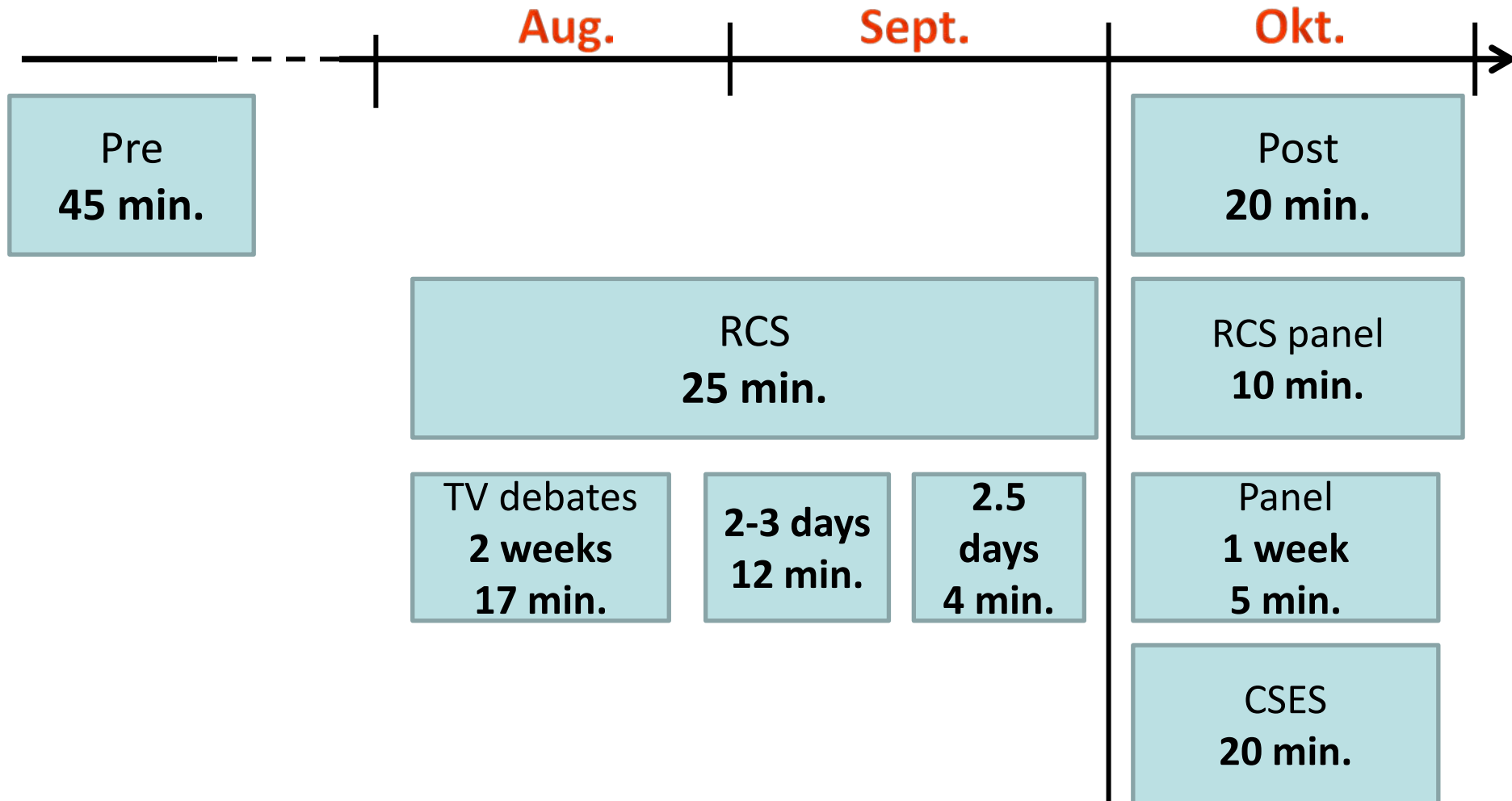
Key points

- 4 different survey companies
- 11,000 respondents

Innovative aspects

- Easily the best election survey data on Austria ever!
- General
 - Large number of respondents
 - Oversampling of young voters
 - Long term: party and media data
- Survey questions
 - Implicit Attitudes Measures (AMP/IAT)
 - Big 5 personality questions, emotional reactions to issues
 - Coalition expectations and desirability
 - List experiments
- Deviations from CSES module
 - additional questions on economic perceptions, leader characteristics, patrimony, campaign contact



The Austrian National Election Study (AUTNES) is a National Research Network, which engages in comprehensive social science analyses of the Austrian national elections. The AUTNES network is funded by the Austrian Science Fund (FWF) from 2009 to 2015 (Grant Reference: S10903-G11). One main aspect of the project is the institutionalization of an integrative study that considers the 'demand side' (voters) and the 'supply side' (political parties and candidates) as well as media coverage of the electoral campaign ('media side'). Relying on this approach the AUTNES makes an important contribution towards a better understanding of the functioning of democracy in Austria.
