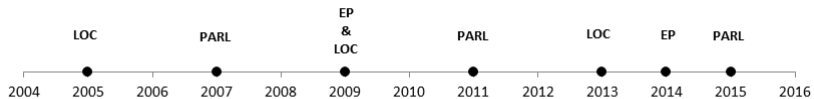
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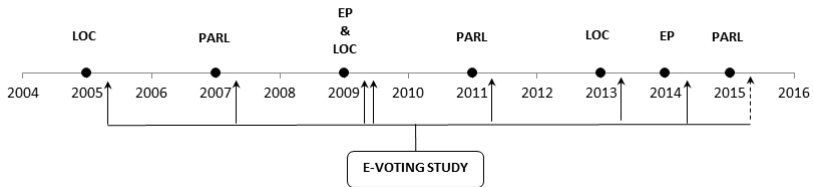

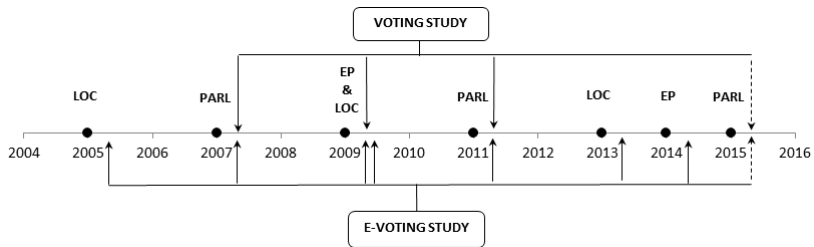
The electoral cycle 2005-2014



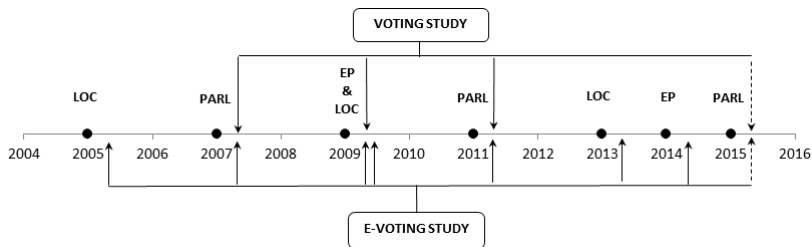
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- E-voting studies: sample size 1000; quota samples in 2005-2011; stratified random samples 2013 - onwards

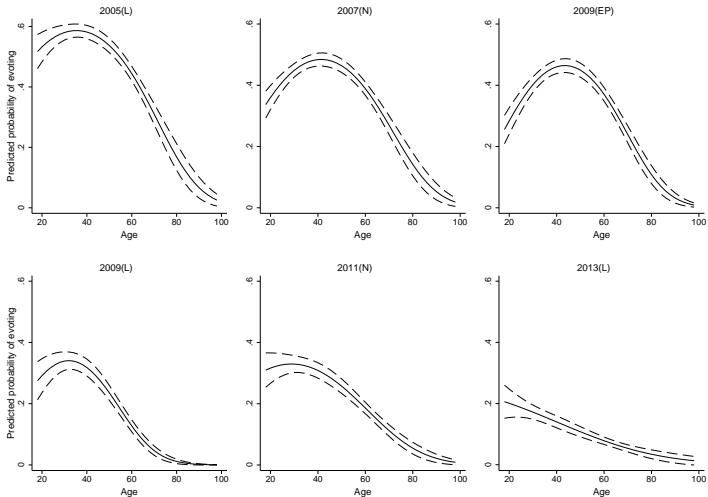
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 - Who are e-voters?
